DOUBLE-DISK EARRINGS (inspired by my double-walled bowls) 14K Gold Filled, Sterling Silver, and/or dark-patinated copper or silver. One metal always has a matte finish. Size of outer disk: Small 1/2" diameter; Large 5/8" diameter.

LEAF JEWELRY (inspired by my leaf plates...or vice versa)

My leaf jewelry reflects my interest in nature. The leaves are made by embossing metal with a dried leaf, similar to a fossil impression in metal. Each piece is made from an actual leaf which can only be used once, therefore each piece is unique! The metal leaves are sawn and shaped by hand. A patina process is used to color the leaves a variegated red. Others are electro-plated with either 24K gold or fine silver.

MAYA MONTH GLYPH NOTE CARDS

INDIAN CHURCH VILLAGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS, BELIZE

All money from the sale of these cards supports the Scholarship Program for the high school children in a small Maya village in Belize, as well as the village library programs. Cards designs reference glyphs from the Maya calendar & the adjacent Maya site of Lamanai. The cards are hand-colored by the children in the village, so each card is unique.

Each set contains one card of each of the 19 Maya months, all on bright colored card-stock paper, plus 3 Lamanai-design cards, with envelopes. Cards are "Invitation Size", 4 3/8" x 5 3/4". Insides are blank so they can be used for any occasion.



The Maya Calendar was far more complex than ours. It was used to determine such things as planting times and astrological divination as well as date keeping. The unit of a day was called a kin. The Maya year, the haab, was composed of nineteen months (uinals). Eighteen months of twenty days each, plus a closing month of just five days, called Uayeb, totaled 365 days.
